You may meet TEFAP income-based standards in either of the following two ways:

- 1. Participate in one of these public assistance programs (PA)
 - Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)
 - SNAP (formerly Food Stamps)
 - Low-income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP)
 - Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)

- Old Age Pension (OAP)
- Aid to Needy Disabled (AND)
- Aid to the Blind (AB)
- Social Security Income (SSI)
- Medicaid Eligible Foster Children
- 2. If you are not participating in any of the above public assistance programs, you must have a combined gross income which does not exceed the maximum income limit for the applicable household size.
