Releasing our Potential into Destiny

I. Introduction – God has created us so His potential could be released in and through us. Anything less than that would deny the purpose of God. The potential of God's creation is determined by its purpose. Everything in creation is designed to function on the simple principle of receiving and releasing. Plants release oxygen we release carbon dioxide. The planet would die without the release of these two things. God has designed us with the response – ability to release what he has naturally and supernaturally given. We are the only ones who can stop that release.

II. Lack does not exist with God

A. The blessing of being heirs.

Because we are heirs of God and joint heirs with Jesus there is never a lack from God's perspective. Because I have the mind of Christ I have God's perspective. I think what God thinks, I say what God says, I do what God does. Everything that is heaven is mine now when I choose it. It is always available.

B. The power of spoken words.

I choose to speak life words. John 6. Nothing happens until something is spoken in God's Kingdom. John 16:12-14. The moment I trust Jesus by faith God initiates my inheritance. Family, blood line, covenant, His DNA all becomes mine, yours. I Cor. 2:8-10; 3:21-23.

In John 2 Jesus said: "my hour (transition into miracle ministry) has not yet come." Under the revelation of God Mary said: "whatever He says do it". By revelation Mary knew it was time. She spoke into being the beginning of Jesus miracle ministry. Jesus immediately said: "go fill the water pots".

In the kingdom of God you will be activated by God to initiate something out of your available inheritance into someone's life. BE READY FOR RAPID FIRE SUDDENLIES. Rapid production and reproduction.

III. Potential manifests in Love relationships.

A. God invites us into a love relationship. (The foundation of our ministry) I John 4:19; 3:1 Everything Father desires flows out of this. Love is how He expresses His pleasure.

God loves us in the same way that God loves God. John 15:9. The measure of God's love (affection) for Jesus is the same measure of His love for us. This is the ultimate statement of our worth and potential. We are God's favorite, His desire, His pleasure. John 17:23-26

Our greatest delight is to know we are the fulfillment of the delight of God.

B. Jesus ministered unto Father (God) out of obedience motivated by His love. John 15:9-10

God is looking for that same love from us. Our highest calling is to move God's heart with our love. Because I am loved by God, my desire is to be a lover of God, for God, with God, through God. Romans 12:1-2; Heb. 13:15-16

Father longs for Holy intimacy, for His own pleasure and yours. Rev. 3:20; Eph. 3:17-19.

What is our purpose and potential? We are here (1) by divine appointment. (2) By Father's design. (3) For His good pleasure. God is ecstatic about you. Hooked on ecstacy. Ek + stasis. To cast oneself out of oneself. God was beside himself. He took of himself and created us/you/me to release His own potential.

C. Jesus calls us to love (minister) as He loved (ministered). Mk. 12:31; Matt. 22:37-40.

When we love father with father's love then we have the potential to love ourselves and each other with the same love. This is God's call to ministry. The only commandment God has.

- 1. Affection (love) based obedience. We experience the affection of Jesus (God) in relationship with Him and then we want to give it back to Him. A (God) love based person will do anything for more love.
- 2. Duty based obedience. Obligation is the motive not affection. At times this may be all I have to give.
- 3. Fear/shame based obedience. Fear of being put to shame. Obedience to God out of fear that God will shame me if I don't.

Note the cycle of Intimacy (love, affection). There is a love revelation of, from and to God. It takes God to love God. It takes God's love to love God. All that begins in heaven ends in heaven when God's love is the motive. Love from God to God. God gives us his love and we give it back. (God expects this as proof of his investment in us).
