- -A means by which God draws us, through the friendship and fellowship of other believers, to Himself.
- "And <u>let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,</u> not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but <u>encouraging one another</u>, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near." -Hebrews 10:24-25
- "But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin." -Hebrews 3:13
- "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ." -Galatians 6:2
